

ČAVEN

 **Path length:** 8,5 km

 **Ascent:** 500 m

 **Path difficulty:** medium

 **Duration:** 5 h

 **Price:** 15 €

 **Terrain:** marked trail

Start in front of the Autocamp Ajdovščina by taking the road towards Lokavec. Our starting point is at the rock tunnels near the Predmeja village. The hike begins at the beautiful Srednje čavenska path. After a two-kilometer of flat, soft, strewn with pine needles path, we climb up to the edge of the Mala gora. When the weather is nice the view from the pasture is magnificent. It is possible to see far over the Karst to the Gulf of Trieste, the town of Savudrija and even further. On the west it is possible to see all over to the Friuli Plain and on the east all over the Nanos plateau to central Slovenia. Right beneath us stretches the Vipava valley. After a short rest we continue our way to the Čaven hut (dinner-optional). The path descends to the village of Predmeja and leads us to the place, where the hike started.

Tunnels – Sredne čavenska path – Mala gora – Čaven (hut) – Predmeja – Tunnels

GOOD TO KNOW

1. Meeting point

In front of the Autocamp Ajdovščina. Transfer by car to the starting point (7 km), surcharge 14 € for 3 pax.

2. Minimum number of participants

3 pax.

3. Equipment

Adequate cycling clothing and footwear, hiking poles, backpack, water min. 1,5 l, energy bars and energy drinks or »lunch package« (optional).
